This bail application has been filed on behalf of the applicant– Md. Ishrafil Ansari @ Md. Israfil Ansari with prayer to release on bail in connection with Penk Narayanpur P.S. Case No. 17 of 2021, registered under Sections 498(A)/323/324/354/379/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of D.P. Act, pending in the court of the A.C.J.M., Bermo at Tenughat.

Learned Counsel for the applicant has submitted that, as per prosecution matrix, the complainant was married with Md. Ishrafil Ansari @ Md. Israfil Ansari on 24.04.2013. Two children were born out of the wedlock. Thereafter a demand of additional dowry was made and for non-fulfilment of the same, complainant was subjected to cruelty. Husband of the informant had gone to Sahudi Arab to earn livelihood. All the members of matrimonial house for non-fulfilment of the alleged demand of additional dowry tortured her and also ousted her from the matrimonial house. On 13.01.2021 the husband of the complainant gave triple Talaq through whatsapp message over mobile phone. Hence F.I.R. was lodged.

Learned Counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant is innocent. Husband of the complainant or his family member never made alleged demand of additional dowry or subjected her to cruelty. Allegations made are general and omnibus. The applicant has been languishing in Jail since 24.05.2022.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State vehemently opposed the contentions made by the learned counsel for the applicant.

In view of the submissions made and materials on record, the bail application of the applicant is hereby allowed. Let the applicant be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned in aforesaid case.
