This bail application has been filed on behalf of the applicant– Karimuddin Momin with prayer to release on bail in connection with Hiranpur P.S. Case No. 41 of 2019, corresponding to S.T. No. 77 of 2021 registered under Sections 406/403 of the Indian Penal Code. Subsequently charge-sheet has been submitted under Section 498 and 366/120B of the Indian Penal Code, pending in the court of Principal Sessions Judge, Pakur.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that, as per F.I.R. allegation, daughter of the informant Naseema Bibi was married with Sadek Momin who was physically handicapped and Naseema Bibi used to maintain the children. Thereafter Naseema Bibi eloped with Karimuddin Momin who is the present applicant. After that a Panchayat was held wherein it was decided that father of Karimuddin Momin, namely, Lokman Momin shall pay a lump sum money of Rs. 75,000/- for maintenance of children and the said amount was handed over on 14.10.2018 to Jikur Molvi who in collusion with present applicant paid only 20,000/- rupees to the informant and rest 50,000/- rupees was not paid. As such misappropriated the said amount.

Learned Counsel for the applicant has submitted, as per allegation made in the F.I.R., as agreed in Panchayat total amount of 70,000/- rupees was paid to the 3<sup>rd</sup> person who did not pay the same to the informant/complainant. The applicant has no complicity or connivance with the said person to whom amount was handed over. The applicant has been languishing in Jail since 24.09.2020.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State vehemently opposed the contentions made by the learned counsel for the applicant.

In view of the submissions made and materials on record, the bail application of the applicant is hereby allowed. Let the applicant be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned in aforesaid case.
