This bail application has been filed on behalf of the applicant– Tata Jaiswal @ Sonu Jaiswal @ Sonu with prayer to release on bail in connection with Sitaramdera P.S. Case No. 122 of 2021(S), registered under Sections 21(a)/29 of the N.D.P.S. Act, pending in the court of the Special Judge, N.D.P.S., Jamshedpur.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that, as per F.I.R. allegations, the informant police officer along with police force after having received information carried out raid at the indicated place and found four persons there. Three persons managed to flee away and one person was apprehended from whose possession 0.72 brown sugar was recovered.

Learned Counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant was not apprehended at the spot rather his name transpired in confessional statement of apprehended co-accused Aman Sandil and no incriminating article was recovered from possession of the applicant. He has been languishing in Jail since 16.12.2021.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State vehemently opposed the contentions made by the learned counsel for the applicant and contended that the applicant is having criminal antecedent of two cases of like nature.

In view of the submissions made and materials on record, the bail application of the applicant is hereby allowed. Let the applicant be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/-(Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned in aforesaid case.
