The applicant, who is in custody since 30.04.2022, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail.

The applicant is named accused of snatching motorcycle but his name has been disclosed on the basis of suspicion.

Innocence has been claimed and participation in the trial has been assured. It has been submitted that the applicant has no criminal antecedent and save and except the confession, there is no other material, connecting the applicant in the alleged offence. On the above facts, prayer for bail has been made.

On the other hand, learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the above fact, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant, above named, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M.1st Class, Jamshedpur, in connection with Sitaramdera P.S. Case No.67 of 2022 on the condition that the applicant will submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
