This bail application has been filed on behalf of the abovenamed applicant with prayer to release on bail in connection with Hunterganj P.S. Case No.179 of 2021 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 325, 307, 504, 302 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code pending in the court of learned C.J.M. Chatra.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the F.I.R. of this case was lodged against six named accused including the applicant with the allegations that on 23.12.2021 at 7 o' clock, all the named accused had assaulted to the brother of the informant on the issue that the cock of the informant entered into the wheat field of accused persons.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that as per F.I.R. allegations, six accused persons had assaulted to the brother of the informant and the eye-witness Suresh Bhuiyan and Bhadan Bharti both have stated that all the accused persons were assaulting with lathi to Ram Nandan Yadav. As per postmortem report, the deceased had sustained two injuries, one was abrasion on the left side of the eye and another was also abrasion and fracture on the wrist. The cause of death was shock and hemorrhage as a result of ante mortem injuries. It is further submitted that the applicants were not having any intention to commit the murder of brother of the informant. The applicant has been languishing in jail since 28.12.2021.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State vehemently opposed the contentions made by the learned counsel for the applicant.

In view of the submissions made and materials on record, the bail application of the applicant is hereby allowed. Let the applicant be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.30,000/-(Rupees Thirty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned in aforesaid case.
