This bail application has been filed on behalf of the abovenamed applicant with prayer to release on bail in connection with Bero P.S. Case No.33 of 2022 registered under Sections 307, 511, 120-B/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25(1-b)a, 26, 27 and 35 of the Arms Act pending in the court of learned J.M. 1st Class, Ranchi.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that as per F.I.R. allegations, the informant—Balku Baraik had lodged the F.I.R. with the allegations that on 04.04.2022 at 06:30 morning he was going to the vegetable market. In the meantime, two miscreants came by white scooty bearing registration no.JH 01 AN 8112 and one of them put pistol on his ear and pushed the trigger of pistol to kill the informant but fortunately the pistol did not open fire. After that the informant started running and the another miscreant fired two rounds from his pistol to disperse the people and both the miscreants were apprehended with the help of police.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that though the name of the applicant figured in the F.I.R., yet despite opening fire, no one sustained any injury. Similarly situated co-accused Sonu Alam @ Mahtab Alam @ Chhotan has already been granted bail by this Bench vide order dated 10.10.2022 passed in B.A. No.7777 of 2022. The applicant has been languishing in jail since 05.04.2022.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State vehemently opposed the contentions made by the learned counsel for the applicant.

In view of the submissions made and materials on record, the bail application of the applicant is hereby allowed. Let the applicant be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned in aforesaid case.
