The applicants, who are in custody since 03.06.2022, have approached this Court for grant of regular bail.

The scuffle has taken place between the parties on refusal to give "Khaini".

Innocence has been claimed and participation in the trial has been assured. It has been submitted that no injury has been found. On the above facts, prayer for bail has been made.

On the other hand, learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the above facts, I am inclined to enlarge the applicants on bail. Accordingly, the applicants, above named, are directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Palamau at Daltonganj in connection with Chainpur P.S. Case No.200 of 2021 on the condition that the applicants will submit self-attested photocopy of their Aadhaar Card and also submit their mobile number before the learned court below which they will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
