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02/25.08.2022      The applicant who is in custody since 28.04.2022 has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in connection with Gidhour P.S. Case No.36 of 2021 corresponding to G.R. Case No.728 of 2021, registered under Sections 147/148/149/ 341/ 342/ 323/ 302 of IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

The applicant was member of unlawful assembly has committed murder and the injuries is firearm injury as well as by sharp edge cutting weapon and both injuries are reasons for death.

Innocence has been claimed and undertaking has been given for participation in the trial. It has been submitted that as per allegation the applicant was merely member of unlawful assembly and the similarly situated co-accused have been granted bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court. On above basis prayer for bail has been made.

On the other hand, learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail of the applicant.

Considering the fact that investigation is complete and the fact that other co-accused have been granted bail, the applicant, named above, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Chatra in connection with Gidhour P.S. Case No.36 of 2021 corresponding to G.R. Case No.728 of 2021, subject to the conditions that the applicant will submit self attested copy of his Aadhar Card and also give his mobile number before the learned court below which he will not change during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
