This bail application has been filed on behalf of the applicant–Nawal Hembrom @ Newal Hembrom with prayer to release on bail in connection with Deori P.S. Case No. 109 of 2021, corresponding to S.T. No. 333 of 2021, registered under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, pending in the court of the District & Additional Sessions Judge-IV, Giridih.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that, as per F.I.R. allegations, daughter of the informant was married with Newal Hembrom and two children were born out of the wedlock. On 01.07.2021 the informant received information that daughter of the informant had set on fire to herself. He reached to the in-laws house and found his daughter dead.

Learned Counsel for the applicant has submitted that, as per F.I.R. allegations, there were petty quarrel between the daughter of informant and the present applicant. The deceased is alleged to have set herself on fire. There is no evidence against the applicant that applicant had abetted her to commit suicide. In this case charge-sheet was also filed and trial has commenced. The independent witnesses of the locality have turned hostile and have not supported the prosecution case. Deposition statements of witnesses have been annexed with the supplementary affidavit. The applicant has been languishing in Jail since 05.07.2021.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State vehemently opposed the contentions made by the learned counsel for the applicant.

In view of the submissions made and materials on record, the bail application of the applicant is hereby allowed. Let the applicant be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.30,000/-(Rupees Thirty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned in aforesaid case.
