This bail application has been filed on behalf of the applicant– Sufi Nazam with prayer to release on bail in connection with Chandil (Kapali) P.S. Case No. 41 of 2022, corresponding to N.D.P.S. Case No.10 of 2022, registered under Sections 21(b) of the N.D.P.S. Act, pending in the court of the Principal District & Sessions Judge, Seraikella.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the F.I.R. of this case was lodged against three named accused including the applicant with these allegations that the informant police officer had carried out raid after having received information and apprehended one person and other two managed to flee away. The apprehended person was identified as Sufil Nazam (applicant) and from possession of the applicant 2.41 gms brown sugar is alleged to be recovered. The alleged recovery was from the person of the applicant. No compliance of Section 50 of the N.D.P.S. Act was made and the recovered contraband was of small quantity and there is no independent witness of the seizure memo. The applicant has been languishing in Jail since 09.03.2022.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State vehemently opposed the contentions made by the learned counsel for the applicant.

In view of the submissions made and materials on record, the bail application of the applicant is hereby allowed. Let the applicant be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned in aforesaid case.
