The applicant, who is in custody since 25.03.2022, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail.

It appears that the victim girl and the applicant are major and it is alleged that the victim girl has been abducted by this applicant.

Innocence has been claimed and it has been submitted that both are students. Undertaking has been for participation in the trial. On the above facts, prayer for bail has been made.

On the other hand, learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the above facts, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant, above named, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M.1st Class, Dhanbad, in connection with Dhansar P.S. Case No.11 of 2022 (G.R. No.1347 of 2022) on the condition that the applicant will submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
