This bail application has been filed on behalf of the abovenamed applicants with prayer to release on bail in connection with Jamtara (Cyber) P.S. Case No.53 of 2020 registered under Sections 414, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, Sections 66(B), 66(C), 66(D) of the I.T. Act pending in the court of learned Additional Sessions Judge-I, Jamtara.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the F.I.R. of this case was lodged against eight named accused persons with the allegations of committing cybercrime. It is further submitted that the name of the applicant transpired in this case during investigation on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused. It is also submitted that no incriminating article was recovered from the possession of the applicant and he has been languishing in jail since 19th July, 2022. The F.I.R. named co-accused, Jakir Hussain @ Ansari and Gul Mohammad Ansari have already been granted bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 17th February, 2021 passed in B.A. No.1174 of 2021.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State vehemently opposed the contentions made by the learned counsel for the applicant and contended that the applicant along with co-accused were involved in commission of the cybercrime.

In view of the submissions made and materials on record, the bail application of the applicant is hereby allowed. Let the applicant be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/-(Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned in aforesaid case.
