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04/01.09.2022 The applicant who is in custody since 29.06.2022 has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in connection with Balumath P.S. Case No.19 of 2019 corresponding to N.D.P.S. Case No.05 of 2020, registered under Sections 18(c) and 29 of N.D.P.S. Act.

It appears that F.I.R. has been lodged against six named and unknown persons for cultivation of poppy plant on the forest land. This applicant is not named in the F.I.R. but subsequently has been roped in on the basis of confession of co-accused.

Innocence has been claimed and undertaking has been given for participation in the trial. It has been submitted that no criminal antecedent has been reported against this applicant. On above basis prayer for bail has been made.

Learned Spl. P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail of the applicant.

Considering the above fact, the applicant, named above, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Latehar in connection with Balumath P.S. Case No.19 of 2019 corresponding to N.D.P.S. Case No.05 of 2020, subject to the conditions that the applicant will submit self attested copy of his Aadhaar Card and also give his mobile number before the learned court below which he will not change during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
