This bail application has been filed on behalf of the abovenamed applicant with prayer to release on bail in connection with Simariya P.S. Case No.60 of 2021 registered under Sections 363-A and 364-A of the Indian Penal Code pending in the court of learned Sessions Judge, Chatra.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the F.I.R. of this case was lodged against bearer of mobile no.9771215752 with the allegations that the informant along with his wife and son had gone to attend a marriage ceremony at the maternal uncle's house. It is further alleged that the 4 years old son of the informant, who was sleeping at the bed was found missing on 22.05.2021 at 11 o'clock of night. Despite search, no whereabouts was known and the missing report was lodged. Thereafter, a phone call came from the mobile no. 9771215752 in the morning over the mobile phone of Ekramul Haque of the village and the caller had told that the child was in his custody. Further the caller had demanded ransom.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that during investigation, the applicant was arrested and on his confessional statement and pointing out the abducted child was recovered. It is further submitted that no money was paid following the alleged demand. The applicant has been languishing in jail since 25.05.2021.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State vehemently opposed the contentions made by the learned counsel for the applicant and contended that the SIM of the alleged mobile number was in the name of the applicant. The child was also recovered on the confessional statement and pointing out of the applicant.

In view of the submissions made and materials on record, the bail application of the applicant is hereby allowed. Let the applicant be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.30,000/-(Rupees Thirty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned in aforesaid case, subject to the following conditions :-



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- i. The applicant will co-operate in the investigation, inquiry and trial and will not absent himself on the date fixed by the learned trial court without any reasonable cause;
- ii. The applicant will not threaten the witness or tamper any evidence;
- iii. One of the surety must be the close relative of the applicant; and
- iv. In breach of any of the conditions, the learned trial court would be at liberty to cancel the bail of the applicant without any further reference to this Court.
