1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned counsel for the State.
2. The applicant who is in custody since 01.06.2022 has approached this Court for grant of regular bail.
3. It appears that the applicant is accused of committing robbery of 'Saal Wood' and has been roped in this case during the investigation.
4. Innocence has been claimed by the learned counsel for the applicant and undertaking has been given for participation in the trial. Further, it has been submitted that there is no incriminating material against this applicant save and except the confession. Similarly situated co-accused persons namely Kalim Ansari in B.A. No.9663 of 2021 vide order dated 17.11.2021, Moin Ansari in B.A. No.13814 of 2021 vide order dated 16.12.2021 and Sajid Ansari in B.A. No.6488 of 2022 vide order dated 06.07.2021, have already been granted bail by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court. On the above basis, the prayer for bail has been made.
5. Learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.
6. Considering the above facts and the fact that the investigation is complete, the applicant, named above, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Gumla in connection with Bharno P.S. Case No.05 of 2020 corresponding to G.R. Case No.634 of 2021, subject to condition that the applicant will submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
