Heard Mr. Arun Kumar Pandey, the learned counsel for the petitioner and Mrs. Priya Shrestha, the learned APP for the State.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the name of this petitioner has come in this case due to suspicion, however, nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that the seized articles from the house of the petitioner have not been put on TI parade. There is no iota of evidence that the petitioner that the petitioner entered into the house of the informant and committed theft and there is also no iota of evidence that he has also committed trespass. It is further submitted that in paragraph 10 it is stated that petitioner is a Auto Driver and he has no criminal antecedent and the petitioner is in custody from 02.12.2021. The learned counsel for the petitioner also cited the bail order of co-accused Md. Parvez @ Raj @ Md. Parwez who has been granted bail in B.A. No. 1088 of 2022 vide order dated 31.03.2022 by a coordinate Bench of this Court and seeks parity.

Learned counsel for the State, on the other hand, has opposed the bail application and pointed out that the allegations in the nature of under section 454 and 380 of the IPC have been made and article has been seized which indicate the petitioner to be guilty of the offence.

Having heard both counsels, gone through the records of the case and in the facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to release the petitioner, named above, on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Jamshedpur in connection with Azadnagar P.S. Case No. 132 of 2021, subject to the condition that petitioner shall report to the concerned police station on every last Saturday

of the month, between 01:00 and 05:00 p.m for one year, failing or if any
adverse remarks regarding his non-appearance at the police station, his bail
application shall be liable to be cancelled. Any exemption to such attendance
shall be done so after direction of the learned Court below.
