The applicant, who is in custody since 09.03.2022, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail.

It appears that on secret information, raid has been conducted in which some persons were apprehended and they had taken the name of this applicant.

Innocence has been claimed and participation in the trial has been assured. Further, similarly situated co-accused has been granted bail by this Court in B.A. No.4869 of 2022 vide order dated 04.07.2022. On the above facts, prayer for bail has been made.

On the other hand, learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the above facts, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant, above named, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sessions Judge, Khunti, in S.T. No.148 of 2022 on the condition that the applicant will submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
