1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned A.P.P.
2. The applicant, who is in custody since 07.07.2022, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in connection with Bharno P.S. Case No.25 of 2022, registered for the offence under Sections 147/ 148/ 149/ 302/ 307/ 353 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 33 of the Indian Forest Act.
3. It appears that it has been alleged that the informant's husband has been killed by thirty five to forty co-villagers as he was objecting for cutting of the trees.
4. Learned counsel for the applicant claims innocence of the applicant and it has been submitted that the applicant has given undertaking to participate in the trial. It has further been submitted that there is no specific allegation against this applicant and further, similarly situated other co-accused persons have already been enlarged on bail. On the above basis, prayer for bail has been made.
5. Learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.
6. Considering the above fact, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant is directed to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Gumla in connection with Bharno P.S. Case No.25 of 2022, on the condition that the applicant will submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
