The applicant, who is in custody since 28.02.2017, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail.

The applicant is an accused for the offence under Sections 364A/34 IPC.

Innocence has been claimed and participation in the trial has been assured. It has been submitted that till date not a single witness has been examined and several similarly situated co-accused have been granted bail by this Court and that has been brought on record. On the above facts, prayer for bail has been made.

On the other hand, learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the period of custody and the fact that not a single witness has been examined till date, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant, above named, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-VI, Palamau at Daltonganj in connection with S.T. No.271 of 2017 arising out of Ramgarh P.S. Case No.13 of 2015, corresponding to G.R. Case No.902 of 2015 on the condition that the applicant will submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
