This bail application has been filed on behalf of the abovenamed applicant with prayer to release on bail in connection with Dhurki P.S. Case No.30 of 2022 registered under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code pending in the court of learned A.C.J.M., Nagar Untari, Garhwa.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that as per F.I.R. allegations, the minor daughter of the informant was alleged to be enticed away by the present applicant on 28.03.2022, who subsequently came back and left his daughter at his house. On being shown resentment by the informant, the applicant misbehaved with the informant and used the words against the daughter of the informant in regard to her bad character.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that as per F.I.R. allegation, the victim is alleged to have been enticed away by the applicant but she was left at the house of the informant. Indeed, the victim had herself accompanied to the applicant and the relation between the victim and applicant was not liked by the informant. On account of same reason, the deceased had committed suicide. There is no evidence against the applicant in regard to abetting her to commit suicide and he has been languishing in jail since 05.07.2022 having no criminal antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State vehemently opposed the contentions made by the learned counsel for the applicant.

In view of the submissions made and materials on record, the bail application of the applicant is hereby allowed. Let the applicant be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned in aforesaid case.
