03/ 11.11.2022 The instant Civil Miscellaneous Petition has been filed for restoration of W.P. (S) No. 1688 of 2015 to its original file, which has been dismissed for default on 07.02.2020 on account of non-compliance of order dated 24.01.2020 passed by this Court.

Mr. Sidhartha Roy, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on 24.01.2020, two weeks time was allowed for removing the defects, but inadvertently same could not be complied with. As the aforesaid order was peremptory, W.P. (S) No.1688 of 2015 stood dismissed on 07.02.2020. It is further submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the aforesaid order shall be complied within eight weeks' from today.

Learned counsel for the opposite parties has no objection to the same.

In view of the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner, W.P. (S) No.1688 of 2015 is restored to its original file, with the condition that the order dated 24.01.2020 passed in W.P.(S) No.1688 of 2015 shall be complied within eight weeks from today and a cost of Rs.1000/- (One Thousand only) is paid by the



petitioner in favour of the Secretary, Department of Women, Child Development & Social Welfare, Govt. of Jharkhand, Ranchi towards the Juvenile Justice Fund, either by cheque or bank draft or can be deposited in the State Bank of India Account No. 3734498462-5, favouring Juvenile Justice Fund, within a period of six weeks’.

Accordingly, the instant C.M.P. stands allowed with the condition as above.
