This appeal is directed against the order dated 29.07.2022 passed in Criminal Misc. Application No.1488 of 2022 by the learned Additional Judicial Commissioner-XV, Ranchi, whereby and whereunder, the prayer for bail of the appellant has been rejected.

A raid was conducted by the police in the house of Navil Akhtar and AK-47 rifle, 06 round revolvers, 06 country made pistols, 09 magazines, 01 country made revolver, 06 more country made pistols and huge number of cartridges of different fire arms as well as explosive substances were recovered from the said place.

The appellant who claims himself to be the brother-in-law of Navil Akhtar was found at the place of occurrence. Although learned counsel for the appellant submits that he is in custody since 27.03.2018 but regard being had to the facts of the case that a huge quantities of arms, ammunition and explosive substances were recovered from the house in which the appellant was present, we are not inclined to release the appellant on bail. Accordingly, this appeal stands dismissed with a direction to the learned court below to expedite the trial and conclude the same preferably within a period of six months from today.

Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed.
