I.A. No.10903 of 2022:

1. The present interlocutory application was filed on behalf of the petitioner on 26th November, 2022 for staying operation of the orders dated 23rd December, 2010 (Annexure-4), 28th February, 2014 (Annexure-5) and 23rd March, 2022 (Annexure-6) as well as restraining the respondent nos.7 to 16 from disturbing the possession of the petitioner by making any construction and further to maintain status quo during pendency of the writ petition.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the present interlocutory application was filed on 26th November, 2022 i.e. about two years back, he does not press the same. However, the petitioner may be given liberty to file a fresh interlocutory application in this regard, if situation so arises in future.
3. Considering the said submission, the present interlocutory application is dismissed as not pressed with the aforesaid liberty.

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4. It has been reported by the office that the notice issued to the respondent nos.7 to 16 have validly been served to them.
5. Mr. A. K. Sahani, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent nos.7, 8 & 11 submits that a counter affidavit on behalf of the said respondents has already been filed.
6. Mr. Manoj Kumar, learned counsel for the respondent no.12 prays for and is allowed four weeks' time to seek instructions and file counter affidavit.
7. Put up this case under the heading "**For Admission**" after four weeks.
