I.A. No.6017 of 2023:

1. The present interlocutory application has been filed on behalf of the petitioners for issuance of direction upon the concerned respondent to keep the grant-in-aid of Rs.60 lakhs allotted to G.S.M.M. College, Garhwa vide letter as contained in memo no.NPU/R/255/23 dated 24th April, 2023 (Annexure-18 to the present interlocutory application) in abeyance till pendency of the writ petition or in alternative they may be directed to disburse the said grant-in-aid under salary head proportionately to all teachers of the said college.
2. Mr. Rajendra Krishna, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present interlocutory application.
3. I.A. No.6017 of 2023 is, accordingly, dismissed as not pressed.

W.P. (S) No.4005 of 2022:

4. It appears that a counter affidavit on behalf of the State respondent has already been filed, however, no counter affidavit has yet been filed on behalf of the respondent nos.5 & 6.

5. Dr. A.K. Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent nos.5 & 6 prays for and is allowed six weeks more time by way of last indulgence to file counter affidavit.
