05/14.02.2023 The grievance of the petitioner as raised in the present writ petition is that though the land appertaining to Khata No. 113, Plot No. 485, Thana No. 140, Mouza-Bajra, measuring an area of 7.70 Acres was mutated in the name of his mother, namely, Koushlya Devi on 28.04.1971, yet subsequently the said plot has erroneously been merged under Khata No. 119 and without appreciating the said fact, the subsequent mutation application filed by his mother has been rejected by the respondent No.3 vide order dated 12.06.2019 passed in Mutation Case No. 1364 R27/2019-2020/Hehal.

According to learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner's mother has subsequently died.

Be that as it may.

Since the mutation application of the petitioner's mother with respect to the land in question has already been rejected by the respondent No.3 vide order dated 12.06.2019 passed in Mutation Case No. 1364 R27/2019-2020/Hehal, I am not inclined to entertain the present writ petition on merit at this stage. The petitioner is however at liberty to prefer an appeal against the order dated 12.06.2019 passed by the respondent No.3, as permissible under law.

The present writ petition is accordingly dismissed as not maintainable with the aforesaid liberty.
