counsel for the respondents.

2. Petitioner, in this writ petition, prays for the following reliefs:-

For issuance of appropriate writ(s)/ order(s)/ direction(s) or
a writ in the nature of Mandamus commanding upon the
concerned respondents to pay the salary to the petitioner
on revised 6th pay scale as on hand and also prayer for
arrear from 2006 as from that date it was in effect, since
after that similar employee are getting same benefits.

3. Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that representation
has already been filed before the Registrar, Ranchi University, Ranchi, but no
action has been taken.

4. Mr. Amit Kumar Sinha, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
Ranchi University, submits that the matter is pending with the State
Government and once the State Government decides the claim of the
petitioner, appropriate consequential action will be taken.

5. Counsel appearing on behalf of the State-respondents submits
that the decision has to be taken at the level of the State Government as to
whether the petitioner is entitled for the relief sought for or not.

6. Considering the submissions of the counsel for the parties, I direct
the Secretary, Higher, Technical and Skilled Development Department,
Government of Jharkhand (respondent No.2) to take a decision and come to a
conclusion as to whether the petitioner is entitled to the reliefs as claimed for in
this writ petition or not. Said decision should be taken within 8 (eight) weeks



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from the date of receipt of a copy of this order along with the representation to be filed by the petitioner. If the petitioner is found entitled to the reliefs as claimed for, necessary consequential action should be taken by the State including sending grant to the Ranchi University for the aforesaid purpose. Upon receipt of such grant, Ranchi University will disburse the same to the petitioner. If the claim of the petitioner is rejected, a reasoned order should be communicated to the petitioner within the aforesaid time.

7. With the aforesaid observations and directions, this writ petition stands disposed of.
