The CROSA Appeal is supported by the delay condonation application, being IA No.01 of 2022, explaining 35 days of delay, which has chanced, in filing the present appeal from order.</p> <p>After hearing the learned counsel for the parties on the delay condonation application, and considering the facts that the limitation for the purposes of Order 41 Rule 22 of the CPC, would have to be construed from the date of the service of the notice on the principal pending appellate proceedings.</p> <p>In that eventuality, the delay of 35 days, which has been explained in the delay condonation application, would be satisfactory.
