			WPCRL No. 1416 of 2022 <u>Shri S.K.Mishra, J.</u> Mr. Nandan Arya, learned counsel for the writ applicants. Mr. J. S. Virk, learned Deputy Advocate General for the State. It is apparent from the record that the alleged incident took place in the National Capital Region, New Delhi and the First Information has been filed at Police Station Kotwali, Dehradun. In that view of the matter, this Court is of the opinion that the Kotwali Dehradun do not have jurisdiction to investigate the matter. Hence, notice be issued to the respondent no.3 through registered post/speed post, acknowledgement due, returnable within 4 weeks. Steps be taken within seven days. Counter affidavit be filed within four weeks. List the matter on 14th September, 2022. Till the next date of listing, the petitioners shall not be arrested in relation with the FIR No. 0314 of 2022, dated 26.06.2022, for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 540, 560, 354 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, PS Kotwali, District Dehradun. However, it is open to the Investigating Officer or to the Station House Officer to forward the FIR to the Police Station having jurisdiction in New Delhi.
