In the interregnum, it is directed that the respondents will not impose any transit fee in relation to the finished goods, which are being transported by the petitioner into the State of Uttarakhand. But this order shall not mean that no transit fee will be charged on forest produce or toll tax and other fees by the National Highway Authority of India.
