			WPSS No. 1551 of 2022 <u>Hon'ble Manoj Kumar Tiwari, J.</u> Mr. Shubhang Dobhal, Advocate for the petitioner. Mr. Narayan Dutt, learned Brief Holder for the State of Uttarakhand. Mr. Himanshu Yadav, Advocate holding brief of Mr. B.S. Bisht, learned counsel for respondent nos. 2 & 3. Heard learned counsel for the parties & perused the record. Petitioner retired from the post of Chief Administrative Officer from Uttarakhand Peyjal Sansadhan Vikas Evam Nirman Nigam, on 30.06.2021. His grievance is that his retiral dues have not been paid so far. By means of this writ petition, petitioner has sought the following reliefs:- i) Issue, Writ, Order or direction in the nature of mandamus commanding / directing the respondents to release the outstanding retiral dues/benefits of the petitioner details whereof is given as under:- <table><tr><td>a. 			appearing for respondent nos. 2 & 3 admits the liability of Nigam to pay the amount of Gratuity & Leave Encashment and submits that although the amount was sanctioned but it could not be paid to petitioner due to financial crunch faced by the Nigam. He, however, assures the Court that outstanding dues of the petitioner will be cleared as soon as funds are received from the State Government. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the writ petition is disposed of with the following directions:- (i) Within a period of two months from today, the amount of Gratuity shall be paid to the petitioner. (ii) Within a period of four months from today, the amount of Leave Encashment & Medical Claim shall be paid to the petitioner. (iii) The request made by Nigam to the State Government, for release of funds, shall be considered and necessary order shall be passed by the Secretary, Drinking Water Department, within fifteen days from the date of production of certified copy of this order.
