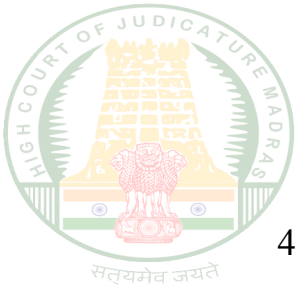
**C.S.Nos. 153 & 154 of 2022****WEB C C.V.KARTHIKEYAN, J.**

The plaintiff and the defendants are agreeable for the Judge Commissioner, who had been earlier appointed namely, Hon'ble Mr.Justice V.Bharadhidasan, to conduct the elections for the term period 2023-2006.

2. Taking all factors into consideration, without entering into any further discussion including, whether the suit is infructuous as on date, to bring about finality to the Governing Council, Hon'ble Mr.Justice V.Bharadhidasan is again appointed as Judge Commissioner to conduct elections for the period 2023-2026. Let adherence be made to Bye Law No.42 of the first respondent society and the schedule may fixed for the elections.

3. The Court records with deep appreciation the service rendered by the Hon'ble Judge on the previous occasion when he assisted the first respondent to conduct the elections for the term periods 2021-2024 and 2022-2025.



4. It is informed by the learned counsel for the first respondent that the Board meeting is scheduled to be held on 19.06.2024. The issue would be whether the seven members who claim right can participate or not.

5. To avoid any controversy, let the Judge Commissioner take charge of the entire issue and call for nominations and proceed with conducting the elections and declare the results. He will be the sole person to take any decision in this regard.

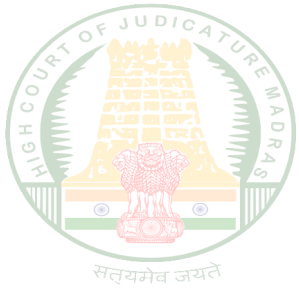
6. In the interregnum period, let not any decision be taken with respect to the membership of the society. On all other aspects, the existing Governing Council can take decisions.

7. The first respondent society may pay an initial remuneration of Rs.1,00,000/- to the learned Judge Commissioner.

8. List the matter once again on 12.07.2024.
