The applicant, who is in custody since 28.08.2021, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in connection with Gandey P.S. Case No.47 of 2019 registered for the offence under Sections 379/411 of the Indian Penal Code.

The applicant is an accused of committing theft of motorcycle.

Innocence has been claimed and participation in the trial has been assured. It has been submitted that the applicant is daily wage worker. Although three criminal antecedents have been reported against the applicant but he has been enlarged on bail in two cases. On the above facts, prayer for bail has been made.

On the other hand, learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail and it has been submitted that there is three criminal antecedents of the same nature.

Considering the period of custody, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant, above named, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M, Giridih, in connection with Gandey P.S. Case No.47 of 2019 on the condition that the applicant will submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court. Further conditions are that one of the bailors will be the Father and the applicant will report to the concerned police station once in a month.
