1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned A.P.P.
2. The applicant, who is in custody since 08.05.2022, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in connection with Bishtupur P.S. Case No.95 of 2022, registered for the offence under Section 21(a) of the N.D.P.S. Act.
3. It appears that the applicant has been made an accused for committing offence under the N.D.P.S Act as 1.83 grams of brown sugar has been recovered from his possession.
4. Learned counsel for the applicant claims innocence of the applicant and it has been submitted that the applicant has no criminal antecedent. It has further been submitted that the applicant has a grocery shop in the Bistupur market.
5. On the other hand, learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.
6. Considering the fact that the quantity recovered is small quantity and the applicant has no criminal antecedent, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant is directed to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Principal District Judge, Jamshedpur in connection with Bishtupur P.S. Case No.95 of 2022, on the condition that the applicant will submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
