1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned A.P.P.
2. The applicant, who is in custody since 02.01.2022, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in connection with Vishunpura P.S. Case No.01 of 2022, registered for the offence under Sections 379 & 414/ 34 of the Indian Penal Code.
3. It appears that the applicant has been made an accused for committing theft of motor-cycle.
4. Learned counsel for the applicant claims innocence of the applicant and it has been submitted that the applicant was merely a rider of the motor-cycle, which was being driven by his friend and he has no concern with the bike in question. It has further been submitted that the the applicant has no criminal antecedent. On the above facts, prayer for bail has been made.
5. On the other hand learned A.P.P has opposed the prayer for bail.
6. Considering the period of custody and the statement of the learned counsel that the applicant has no criminal antecedent, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant is directed to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Garhwa, in connection with Vishunpura P.S. Case No.01 of 2022, on the condition that the applicant will submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
