The bail application has been filed on behalf of the abovenamed applicant with a prayer to release on bail in connection with Hazaribag Sadar P.S. Case No.212/2055 under sections 341, 323, 325, 307, 387, 34 of the Indian Penal Code pending in the court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hazaribag.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the FIR of this case was lodged against 3 named accused including the applicant with these allegations that on 06.06.2022, Bijay Ray @ Bijay Rai along with his two sons came to the house and made demand of ransom. On being opposed all the three assaulted to the informant and his senior Sudhir Prasad Singh came to rescue, he also sustained injuries. However, other associates of the informant rescued him. The accused persons had also snatched away Rs.50,000/- from his pocket.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the allegations made in the FIR against all the 3 accused is general and omnibus. As per injury report the informant sustained only one injury which is simple in nature. There is no injury report of the witness Sudhir Prasad Singh who came to rescue informant. The applicant has been languishing in jail since 07.06.2022.

Learned APP for the State vehemently opposed the contentions made by the learned counsel for the applicant.

In view of the submissions made and the materials on record, the bail application of the applicant is allowed. Let the applicant be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned in the aforesaid case.
