1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned A.P.P.
2. The applicant, who is in custody since 10.05.2022, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in connection with Ghaghra P.S. Case No.57 of 2022, registered for the offence under Sections 392, 411 and 413 of the Indian Penal Code.
3. It appears that F.I.R has been lodged against three unknown persons for snatching the mobile phone of the informant. This applicant has been roped in on the basis of the confessional statement of co-accused.
4. Learned counsel for the applicant claims innocence of the applicant and undertaking has been given to participate in the trial. It has been submitted that the co-accused have already been granted bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide orders dated 07.07.2022 & 13.07.2022, passed in B.A. Nos.7015 of 2022 & 6986 of 2022.
5. On the other hand, learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.
6. Considering the period of custody and the fact that the other co-accused have already been enlarged on bail, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant is directed to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Gumla in connection with Ghaghra P.S. Case No.57 of 2022, on the condition that the applicant will submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
