The bail application has been filed on behalf of the abovenamed applicant with a prayer to release on bail in connection with Thakurgaon P.S. Case No.59/2021 under section 394 of the Indian Penal Code and section 27 of the Arms Act, pending in the court of learned J.M. 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Ranchi.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that FIR of this case was lodged against 2 named accused including the applicant with these allegations that on 31.12.2021, the informant had gone by his motorcycle to Patratu where two persons Om Prakash Mahto and Deepak Kumar Mahto were already roaming. As he reached near the Beti Ghati at the lonely place these two persons asked him to stop the motorcycle and took away the key of the motorcycle and mobile phone on the pointing of pistol.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the name of the applicant figured in the FIR. The alleged stolen property was not recovered from the possession of the applicant. The alleged motorcycle was recovered from the jungle. The applicant has been languishing in jail since 02.01.2022.

Learned Spl.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State vehemently opposed the contentions made by the learned counsel for the applicant.

In view of the submissions made and material on record, the bail application of the applicant is hereby allowed. Let the applicant be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/-(Rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned in the aforesaid case.
