The applicant, who is in custody since 24.04.2022, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in connection with Narkopi P.S. Case No.24 of 2022 registered for the offence under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 325, 307, 333, 353, 295 (A) & 153(A) of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against this applicant is about throwing stones in which some persons got injured.

Innocence has been claimed and it has been submitted that FIR has been lodged against 22 named accused including this applicant. However, he is not responsible for any offence under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code. The applicant has no criminal antecedent. Similarly situated co-accused have already been granted bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 24.06.2022 passed in B.A. No. 6267 of 2022. On the above facts, prayer for bail has been made.

On the other hand, learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering above facts, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant, above named, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M., Ranchi, in connection with Narkopi P.S. Case No.24 of 2022 on the condition that the applicant will submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
