Heard Mr. Jitendra Nath Upadhyay, the learned counsel for the petitioner and Mrs. Snehlika Bhagat, the learned APP for the State.

Mr. Jitendra Nath Upadhyay, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been implicated in this case for no fault of his. The petitioner is not named in the FIR and he has been made accused on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused. It is further submitted that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The learned counsel for the petitioner further submitted that the petitioner is only the labourer and he used to do his work of loading and unloading of the materials from the vehicle and even on the date of occurrence he was loading and unloading the materials but he has no knowledge that the materials being loaded and unloaded is stolen material. He is merely a labourer and has no criminal antecedent.

Learned counsel for the State, on the other hand, has opposed the bail petition and pointed out that his name has come on the confessional of another co-accused and he has also made confession. It is further submitted that on the pointing out of the petitioner stolen material recovered from a godown. The mobile number indicated in the FIR/fardbeyan belongs to some other persons and during investigation it has come that this petitioner was using this mobile number.

Having heard both counsels, gone through the records of the case and in the facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to release the petitioner, named above, on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate at Ghatshila in connection with Galudih P.S. Case No. 08 of 2022.
