The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence as alleged in the FIR. The learned counsel has further submitted that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and nothing has been recovered from the physical and conscious possession of the petitioner. The learned counsel has further submitted that the co-accused, namely, Ramadhan Paswan @ Ramadhan Ram @ Ramadhar Ram @ Ramadhar Paswan in BA No.11110 of 2020; Bimlesh Pal in BA No.349 of 2021; Chandradev Pal in BA No.4660 of 2021, and; Rajendra Paswan @ Rajendra Ram @ Rajendra Kumar in BA No.16123 of 2021 have been granted bail by co-ordinate Benches of this Court *vide* orders dated 18.01.2021, 04.02.2021, 21.06.2021, and 08.02.2022 respectively. Moreover, the petitioner is in custody since 10.03.2022. Therefore, petitioner may be released on bail.

Learned APP, appearing on behalf of the State, has vehemently opposed the bail application of the petitioner and has submitted that the allegations are under sections 302 and 201 IPC, however, does not deny the cited bail orders.

Having gone through the records of the case and the arguments advanced by the learned counsel for both the sides, present petitioner, named above, is ordered to be released on bail on executing bail bonds of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge VI, Palamau at Daltonganj in connection with Hussainabad P.S. Case No. 162 of 2020, corresponding to GR No.2100 of 2020 (ST Case No.204 of 2022).
