1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned A.P.P.
2. The applicant, who is in custody since 25.06.2022, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in connection with Mandu (W.B) P.S. Case No.139 of 2022, registered for the offence under Section 394 of the Indian Penal Code.
3. It appears that the applicant has been made an accused for committing road robbery of Rs.6,000/- from the truck driver.
4. Learned counsel for the applicant claims innocence of the applicant and it has been submitted that the applicant has given undertaking to participate in the trial. It has further been submitted that he is a poor labourer and he has to take care of his old aged mother. On the above basis, prayer for bail has been made.
5. Learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.
6. Considering the period of custody, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant is directed to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Ramgarh in connection with Mandu (W.B) P.S. Case No.139 of 2022, on the condition that the applicant will submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
