



5. Yesterday, this matter was listed. It was adjourned for today, so that learned State counsel may get instruction as to what evidence is available against the applicant, apart from the statement of the co-accused.

6. Today, learned counsel for the State would submit that at this stage, the applicant is involved, merely on the statement of the co-accused.

7. Having considered the rival submissions, this Court is of the view that the applicant deserves to be enlarged on bail.

8. The bail application is allowed.

9. Let the applicant Surendra Giri be released on bail, on his executing a personal bond and furnishing two reliable sureties, each of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Court concerned.
