Khulbe, J.</u></b></p> <p>Mr. Akram Parvez, learned counsel for the applicant.</p> <p>Mr. Pankaj Joshi, learned B.H. for the State.</p> <p>This is the second bail application moved on behalf of accused–Pradeep, who is in judicial custody in connection with Case Crime/FIR No.50 of 2021, u/s 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at P.S. Dharasu, Distt. Uttarkashi..</p> <p>The first bail application has been treated as short-term bail application, vide order dated 24.09.2021.</p> <p>It is argued by the learned counsel for the accused that the accused is in judicial custody; co-accused Sandeep has already been enlarged on bail by this Court vide order dated 09.12.2021; a compromise had taken place between the parties; accordingly, the present accused is entitled for bail on the ground of parity.</p> <p>Learned State counsel although opposed for bail but fairly submitted that the above co-accused, namely, Sandeep has already been enlarged on bail.</p> <p>From the perusal of Annexure-7, it is clear that the informant and both the accused has submitted a compounding application before the concerned Court in proceedings u/s 482 Cr.P.C, in which the informant-Ranveer Singh Mahant has also filed an affidavit; as per the affidavit, the</p>

compromise had taken place between the parties.

Co-accused Sandeep has already been bailed out vide order dated 09.12.2021 by this Court and the role assigned to the applicant is identical; accordingly, without going into merits of the case, it is a fit case for bail at this stage on parity.

The bail application is thus, allowed and the applicant is directed to be released on bail on his executing a personal bond and furnishing two reliable sureties, each of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Court concerned.

Pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
