Order : This petition coming on this day for hearing upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.M.DEVI RUDRA, Advocate for the Petitioner and of MR.M.GANESAN, STANDING COUNSEL for the Respondents, the court made the following order:-

Mr.M.Ganesan, learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondent Corporation made a submission that the petitioner has not submitted a proper application in the prescribed format for consideration in accordance with the provisions of the Chennai City Municipal Corporation Act, 1919.

2. The learned Standing Counsel further submitted that the petitioner is not holding a valid license to run a flour mill and, therefore, actions were initiated against the petitioner. The petitioner is continuing the business for a longer period without any proper licence.

3. Considering the submissions made by the learned Standing Counsel for the respondents, the petitioner is at liberty to submit a proper application in the prescribed format by complying with the requirements and conditions stipulated in the Act. In the event of submitting such application in the prescribed format, the same shall be considered on merits and in accordance with law by the respondent Corporation.

4. It is made clear that in the event of not submitting the proper application in the prescribed format by the petitioner within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, the respondent Corporation is at liberty to initiate all actions in accordance with law.
