Gangsters and Anti Social Activities (Prevention) Act, 1986, registered at Police Station – Jwalapur, District - Haridwar.</p> <p data-bbox="662 1030 1487 1249">Learned AGA, on instructions, submits that there are as many as 18 criminal cases pending against the petitioner, which involves offences under Section 307, 420, 452, 387, 467, 468 IPC and other serious offences.</p> <p data-bbox="662 1261 1487 1668">Keeping in view the nature of allegations made against the petitioner and pending such higher number of criminal cases, this Court is of the prima facie view that this is not a fit case for quashing of the FIR lodged against the petitioner under provisions of the U.P. Gangsters and Anti Social Activities (Prevention) Act, 1986. Hence, this Court is not inclined to entertain this writ petition.
