Rawat, Brief Holder for the State of Uttarakhand.</p> <p>Heard learned counsel for the parties.</p> <p>Petitioner had applied for Child Care Leave on various occasions, however, such leave was not sanctioned to petitioner on two occasions, and instead extraordinary leave was sanctioned to her. Grievance of petitioner is that not only Child Care Leave was denied to her on those occasions, but, also adverse remark was also made against petitioner in her service book.</p> <p>After arguing for a while, learned counsel for petitioner submits that petitioner has made representation, but no heed was taken by the Competent Authority on the same. He confines his prayer and submits that petitioner may be permitted to make fresh representation to respondent no. 2, who</p>

may be directed to take decision thereupon.

Learned State Counsel fairly submits that if petitioner makes representation to respondent no. 2, the same shall be dealt with as per law.

Accordingly, writ petition is disposed of with liberty to petitioner to make fresh representation to respondent no. 2, within two weeks from today. If such representation is made, respondent no. 2 shall consider petitioner's request and take appropriate decision, as per law, within 10 weeks from the date for receipt of representation, with certified copy of this order.
