DAILY ORDER

1. The matter was kept for hearing 24.09.2021.
2. Ld. Adv. Mr. Abhishek Mukhopadhyay, a proxy advocate appearing for Advocate on Record Shri Arijit Maitra for the Petitioners submitted that Respondent DGVCL has filed its reply in the matter but rejoinder-reply is yet to be filed by the Petitioners. Moreover, other Respondents are yet to file their reply and therefore, the Commission may direct other Respondents to file their reply in the matter and thereafter, the Petitioners may be granted three weeks to file their rejoinder reply. Accordingly, the matter may be adjourned and requested that the Commission may keep virtual hearing through V.C. on next date.
3. Ld. Adv. Mr. Anand Ganesan, on behalf of the Respondent No.'s 1 to 3 submitted that there is no objection to the adjournment as well as virtual hearing on next date.
4. We note that proxy Advocate appearing for Advocate on Record Shri Arijit Maitra has sought for an adjournment which is not objected by Ld. counsel for Respondent No.'s 1 to 3. It is also submitted that the Petitioner is yet to file its rejoinder to reply filed by Respondent DGVCL for which three weeks' time be granted. Let the rejoinder reply be filed by the Petitioners within three weeks. Other Respondents No. 2 to 5 have not filed their reply in the matter, are at liberty to file their reply, if any, within 1 week from date of this Order with a copy to the Petitioners. Thereafter, the Petitioners are at liberty to file rejoinder reply within two (2) weeks with a copy to the Respondents.
5. Considering the request of Petitioners to adjourn the matter and other side having no objection to the same, the matter is adjourned. At joint request for virtual hearing, the next date of hearing is 21.10.2021 at 11:30 A.M. through V.C. on Microsoft teams. Staff of the Commission is directed to provide necessary link to parties in these matters.
