**DAILY ORDER**

1. The matter was kept for hearing on 26.08.2025.
2. At the outset, Ld. Adv. Mr. Utkarsh Singh appearing for the Petitioner submitted that on the previous hearing the Respondent did not remain present. He requested the Commission to close the Rights for further submissions / pleadings of the Respondent and grant a short date for hearing.
3. The office of the Commission has received an email seeking adjournment in the matter, which is also marked to the Petitioner GUVNL. In the said email it is stated that the Respondent could not attend the hearing due to short notice of hearing on 26.08.2025 and other grounds stated therein.
4. Heard the Petitioner. We note that the Ld. Adv. Mr. Utkarsh Singh appearing on behalf of the Respondent submitted that the Respondent did not remain present in the last hearing. We also note that the Respondent has sent an email to the office of the Commission and the Petitioner stating its inability to remain present during the hearing and also sought time of 3 months to file its submissions. As the Respondent is not appearing before the Commission since last two hearing kept on 13.07.2023 and 22.12.2023. Considering the request of the Respondent, we are of the view to grant one last opportunity to the Respondent either to remain in person or through its legal representative in the matter and also file its Reply to the Rejoinder within four weeks' time with a copy to the Petitioner.
