1. The matter was kept for hearing on 29.08.2025.

Adv. appearing on behalf of the Petitioner submitted that the present Petition was filed before the Commission in the year 2022, thereafter the power plant was commissioned in April 2024 and the Petitioner is supplying power to the Respondent. Hence, she requested the Commission to allow the filing of the Application to bring the current facts on record.
3. Ld. Adv. Srishti Kindaria appearing on behalf of the Respondent submitted that the Respondents should also be allowed to file their reply to the said new facts in the Petition.
