**DAILY ORDER**

1. The matter was listed for hearing on 08.01.2026.
2. When the matter was called out, nobody appeared on behalf of the Petitioner, despite of the hearing notice was issued to the Petitioner.
3. Ld. Adv. Mr. Aneesh Bajaj, appearing on behalf of the Respondent GETCO, submitted that the Petitioner has filed the present Petition seeking for

clarification on account of difficulty in implementation related to the Procedure for Grant of Connectivity to Projects based on Renewable Energy sources to the Intra-State Transmission System issued by the Respondent GETCO and approved by the Commission on 07.01.2023. However, it is submitted that the Petitioner under the guise of seeking clarification and power to remove difficulty is in effect seeking amendment /modification of the Detailed Procedure which cannot be permitted. As such, there is no difficulty in implementing the procedure but only that the members of the Petitioner are allegedly affected by the application of the said Detailed Procedure. He further submitted that the Commission also approved new the Detailed Procedure for grant of connectivity to projects based on renewable sources to Intra-State Transmission system on 04.08.2025 and the same has not been challenged before the Commission by the Petitioner. Hence, the prayers of the Petitioner are satisfied in terms of the Approved Detailed Procedure dated 04.08.2025. However, the Commission may provide an opportunity of the hearing to the Petitioner to clear its stand in the present matter.

4. The Commission notes that the present Petition has been filed by the Petitioner under Sections 86 of the Electricity Act, 2003 seeking clarification on account of difficulties in implementation related to the Procedure for grant of connectivity to the Projects based on Renewable Energy sources to the Intra-State Transmission system issued by the Respondent No. 1 GETCO and approved by the Commission in line with GERC (Terms and Conditions of Intra-State Open Access) Regulations, 2011. We note that when the matter was called out, nobody was present on behalf of the Petitioner although the hearing notice was issued to them. We also note that the Petitioner neither remained present during today's proceedings nor made any written communication about their inability to remain present, despite being served the hearing notice to them.

4.1. We note that the Petitioner has not remained present today and the Respondent GETCO has requested to the Commission to provide an opportunity of the hearing to the Petitioner to clear its stand in the present matter. Hence, we decide to provide one last opportunity of hearing prior to deciding the matter and adjourn the matter on account of non-appearance of the Petitioner. We direct the Petitioner Indian Wind Energy Association to remain present during the next date of hearing. We also make it clear that if the Petitioner does not remain present during the next date of hearing, the Commission will decide the matter based on the records of the present Petition and no further adjournment shall be granted.

5. The next date of hearing will be intimated separately.

6. Order accordingly.
